The Kerwood Scholarships**

The Oregon High School Racquetball League Student Athlete Scholarship program is named in honor of Gary Kerwood, one of the founders of the League and of the Oregon Junior Racquetball Association. The Kerwood Scholarship Program (the "Program") is a scholarship awards program administered under the auspices of the Board of Directors (the "Board") of the Oregon Junior Racquetball Association (the "OJRA"), an Oregon non-profit tax exempt corporation.

**COMMITTEE:**

The scholarship committee (the "Committee") consists of one or more persons appointed by the OHSRL commissioner. The Committee will have the responsibility for the Program's overall operation. The Committee will have the authority to establish application policies and procedures, review applications and submit their evaluation and recommendations to the Board. The Committee will present its recommendations regarding the number and dollar amounts of scholarships to be awarded for the ensuing year to the Board at a meeting of the Board. The Committee is not required to recommend any minimum number or amount of scholarships, even if otherwise qualified applicants have applied, and may include in its evaluation any criteria which it desires, including, but not limited to, the availability of funds to support the Program. For school year 2016-2017, it is expected that at least four scholarships will be available in the amount of \$500 each.

**ADMINISTRATION:**

Receipt, preparation and assembly of all scholarship applications will be done by the Committee. Notification of applicants concerning selection, arrangement for the disbursement of funds, and any other administrative tasks required, will be done by the Committee.

**GRANTS:**

The Board will publicize the Kerwood Scholarship Program in its publications, mailings and other outreach. Grants will not be limited by race, color, creed, sex, religion, or national origin. Recipients may attend the college, university, vocational/technical school or junior college of their choice.

**FUNDS:**

Funds for the scholarships will be provided from donations to the scholarship fund by interested persons or other fund raisers that may be approved by the Board. Grant monies may be applied to payment of tuition, textbooks, instructional material, room/board directly related to the field of study. In the event that the student fails to attend, withdraws, or transfers from the institution, the unused portion of the grant will be returned to the OHSRL.

**ELIGIBILITY:**

An applicant must be an USAR member at the time the grant request is made and must have played in at least one sanctioned Oregon High School Racquetball League match during the player's senior year of high school. All applicants must enroll in a full-time program as prescribed by the college, university, vocational/technical school, junior college or other eligible educational institution, during the grant period.

**APPLYING FOR A SCHOLARSHIP:**

Applicants may obtain a scholarship application OregonRacquetball.org, from their high school racquetball coaches or by calling Megan Menzia at 503-516-4305. The scholarship application, all forms and instructions for completing the application are included in this document. The completed application with all enclosures must be physically received by no later than June 30, 2017, to be eligible. **LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE CONSIDERED.** The deadline has been set to allow sufficient time after the OJRA Regional Racquetball Championships for all interested persons to apply. Only one application per student will be accepted.

**PAYMENT OF GRANTS:**

Scholarship grant checks will be mailed to the student’s school on or about October 15 of the school year. Confirmation of full-time enrollment must be provided to the Committee before the check will be issued. In the event the student fails to attend, withdraws, or transfers to another institution, the unused portion of the grant must be returned to the OJRA. Grants must be paid before February 15 of the school year for which the grant was earned or any unused amounts will be forfeited and returned to the OJRA.

**SELECTION CRITERIA:**

Applications will be considered for scholarship grants based on the evaluation of the following factors:

a. **Scholastic Achievement**

Points are awarded for:

(1) Cumulative GPA (25% of the overall total)

(2) Senior Year GPA (25% of the overall total)

GPA will be given the following points:

- b. How will you continue to be engaged in racquetball after high school?
- c. Why is racquetball an important part of your life?

## INSTRUCTIONS FOR COMPLETING THE KERWOOD SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION

These instructions pertain to the submission of the Kerwood Scholarship applications and are furnished to ensure that you, as an applicant, understand the requirements of the scholarship program, and that your application is completed and correctly submitted. In order to qualify for Kerwood Scholarship, the student must be an USAR member at the time the application is submitted. All students must be enrolled or accepted for enrollment in a full-time program as prescribed by the college, university, vocational/technical school, junior college or other eligible educational institution during the entire grant period. Grant periods are for one year, unless otherwise specified.

The following is a check list of required documents:

1. Scholarship application completed and signed (includes applicant photograph release)
2. Essay of at least 200 words and no more than 1,000 words that answers the following three questions:
  - a. When and why did you start playing racquetball?
  - b. How will you continue to be engaged in racquetball after high school?
  - c. Why is racquetball an important part of your life?
3. Copy of your most-recent high school transcript
4. Current photograph

Only an original application will be accepted. Faxes, copies and like reproductions are not acceptable. Completed applications must be physically received by a member of the Committee either in person or at the address specified below by June 30, 2017, to be eligible. **LATE APPLICATIONS WILL NOT BE ACCEPTED.** Please retain a full copy of your completed application. It is strongly recommended that you send the application by certified mail, so that you can have proof that it was mailed.

### GENERAL INFORMATION:

The following general information concerning the scholarship program should be noted:

Applicants considered for scholarships will be advised in writing as to the selection or non-selection. The Kerwood Scholarships are not limited by race, color, creed, sex, religion, or national origin.

The applicant must submit a completed application in full. Only one copy of the application and documents are necessary. It shall not be the responsibility of the Committee to assist the applicant in submitting a completed application.
